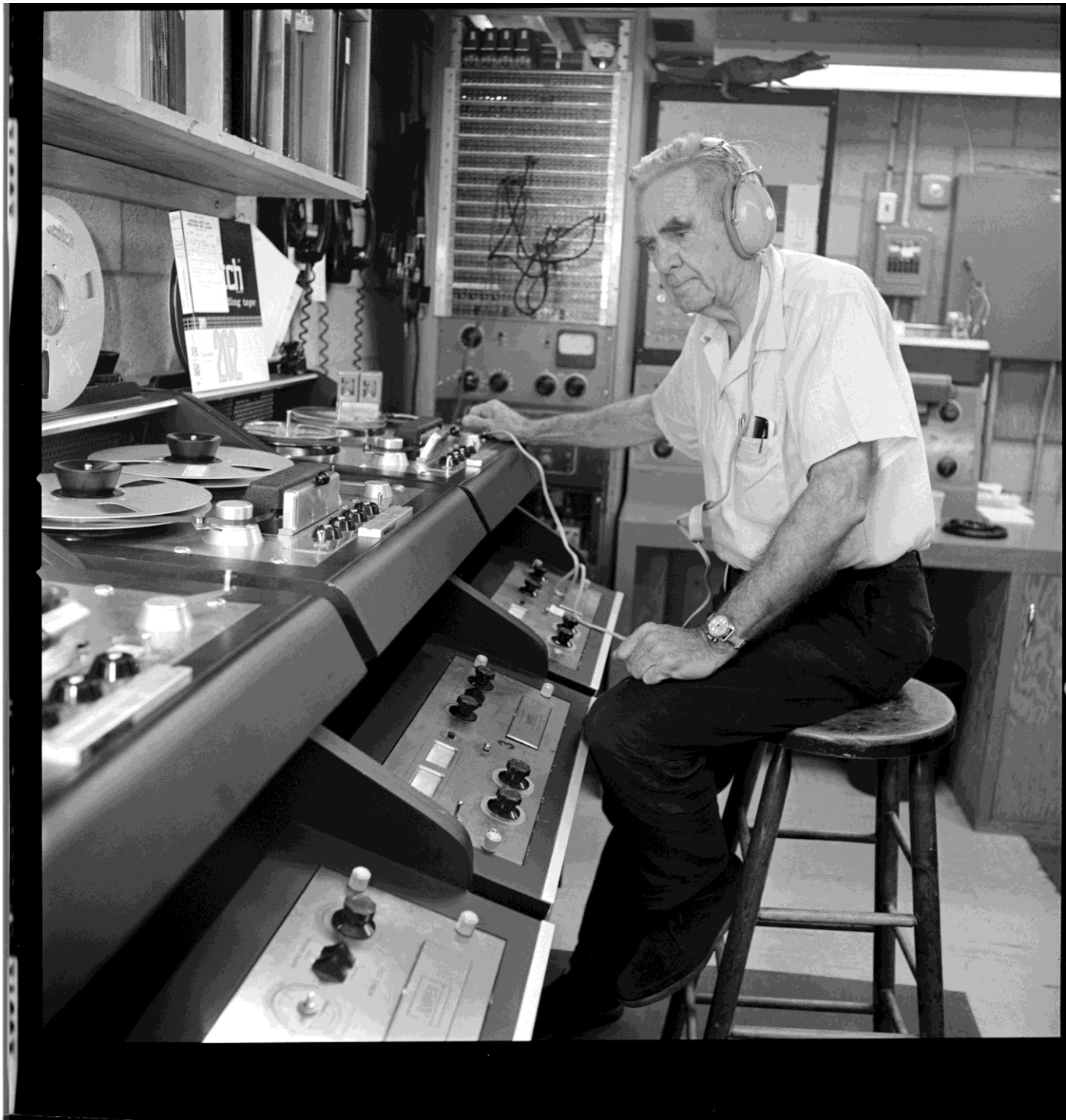

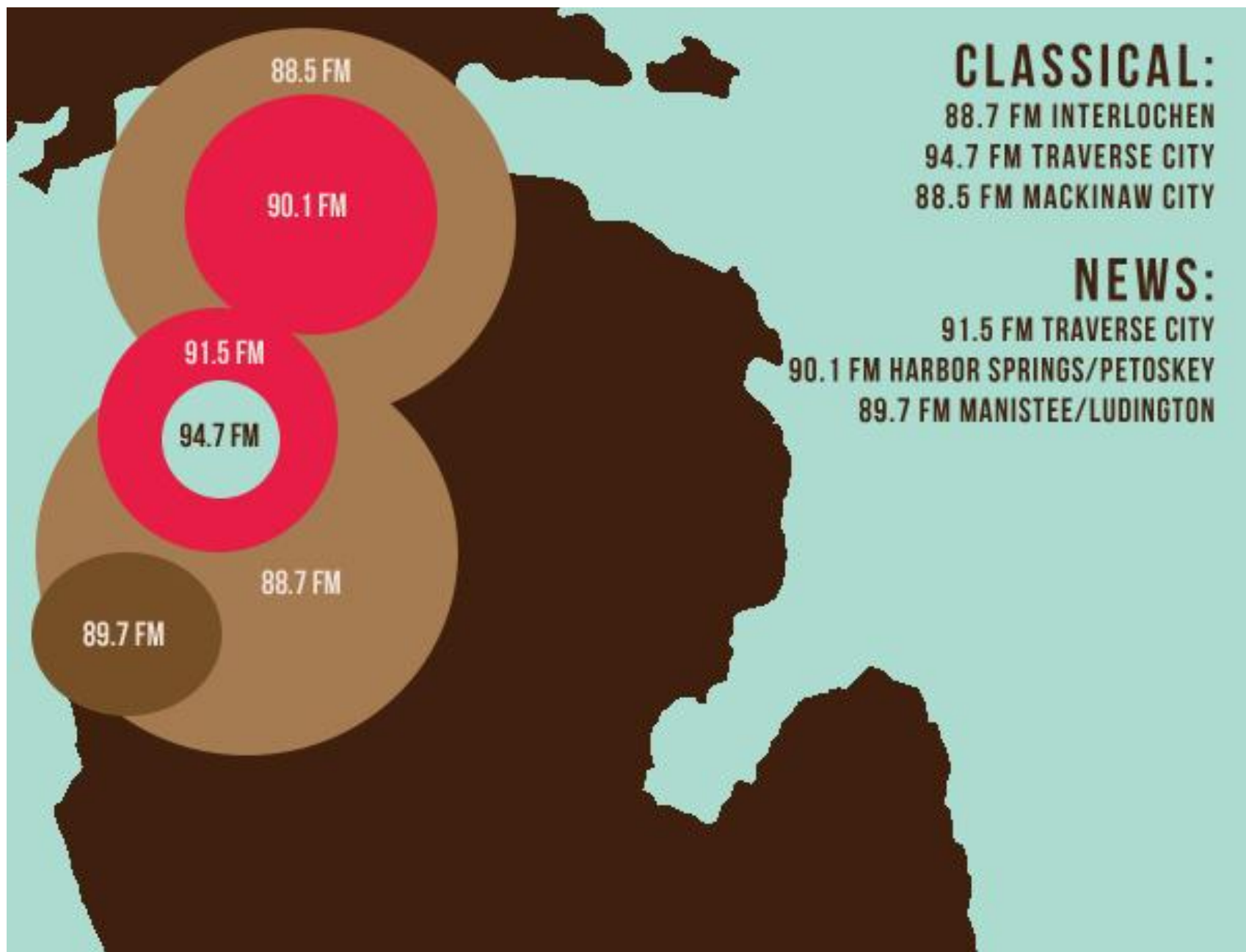
thereby constituting a majority of the Board of Directors.

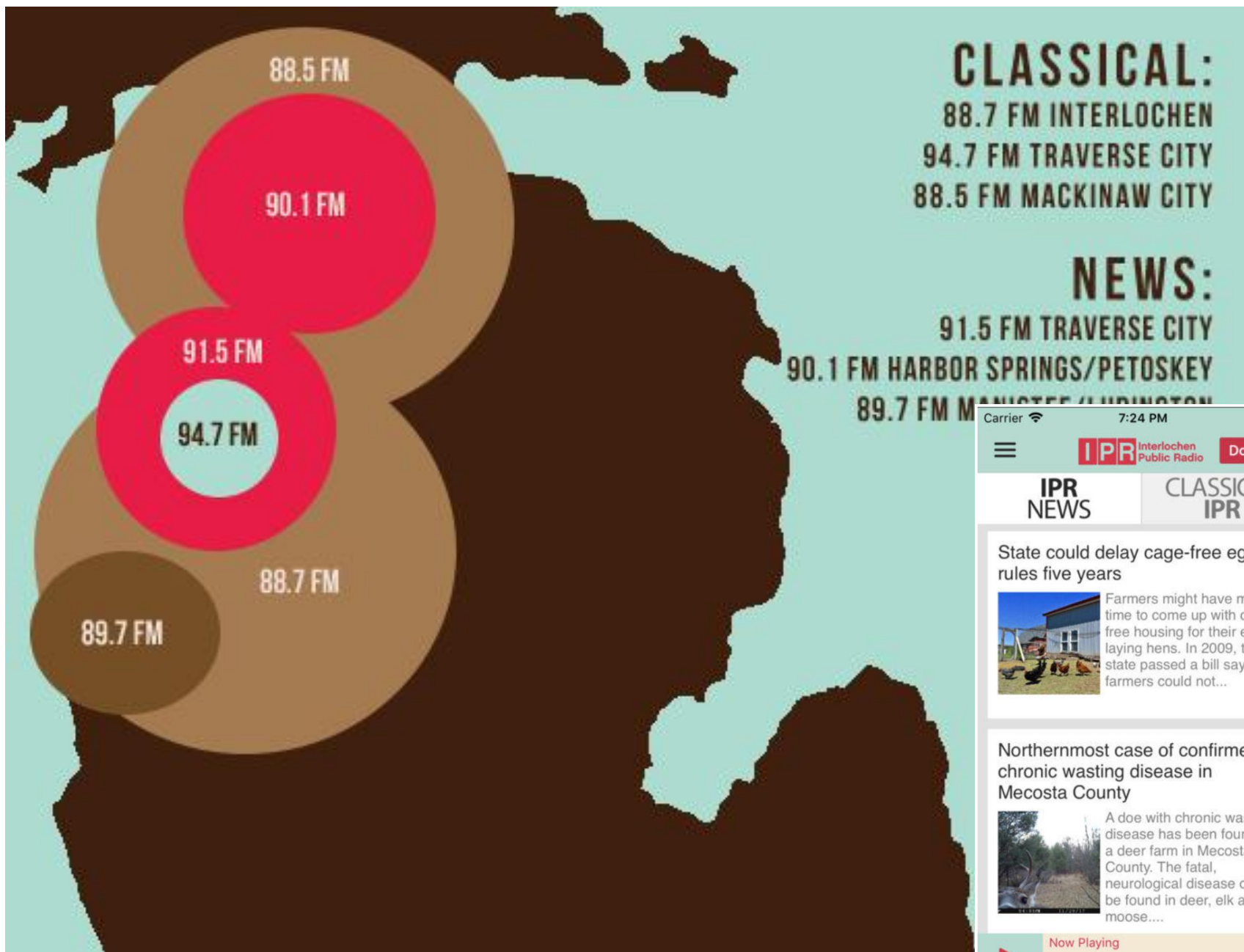

What happens when you take three members of the Traverse Symphony Orchestra and their music director, keep them six feet apart, strictly limit their audience size and ask them to play while wearing masks?

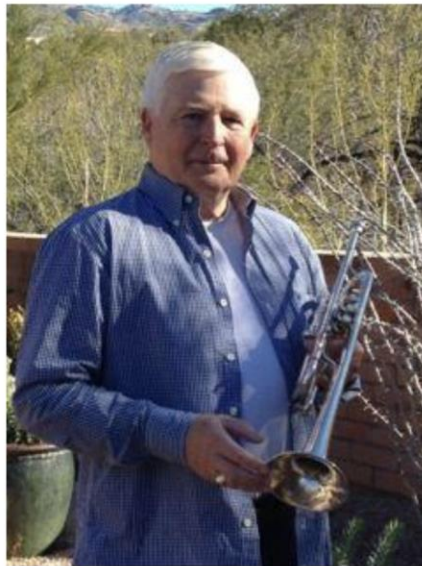

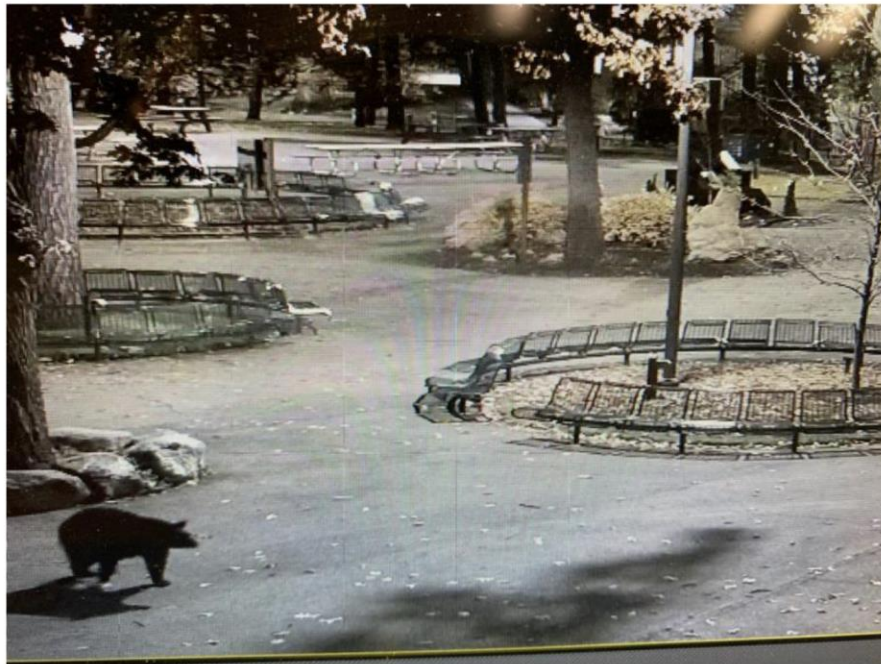

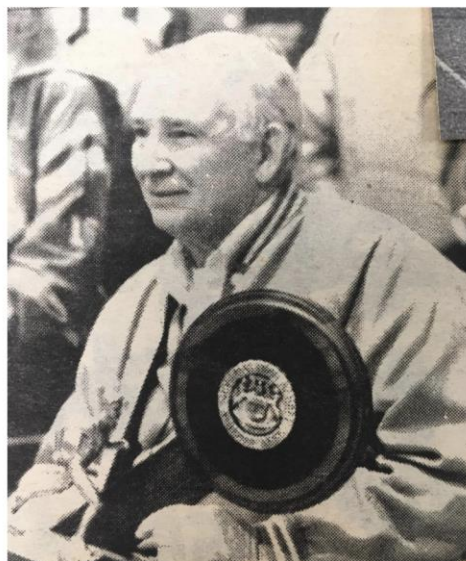
